### FESTIVAL OF ARCHAEOLOGY

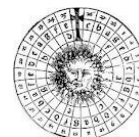
To celebrate the Festival of Archaeology, Newport Roman Villa will be having a special open day on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> July, 11am – 3pm
