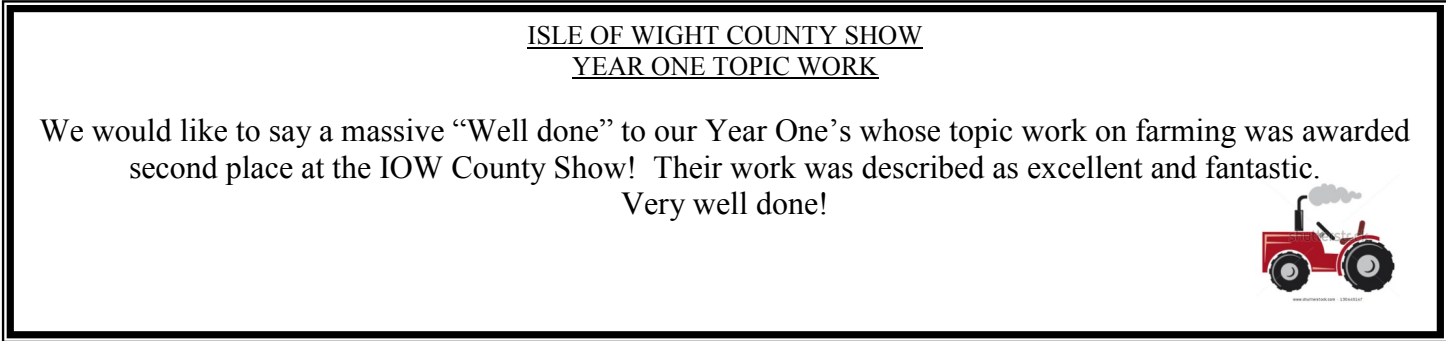
We would like to say a massive “Well done” to our Year One’s whose topic work on farming was awarded second place at the IOW County Show! Their work was described as excellent and fantastic.

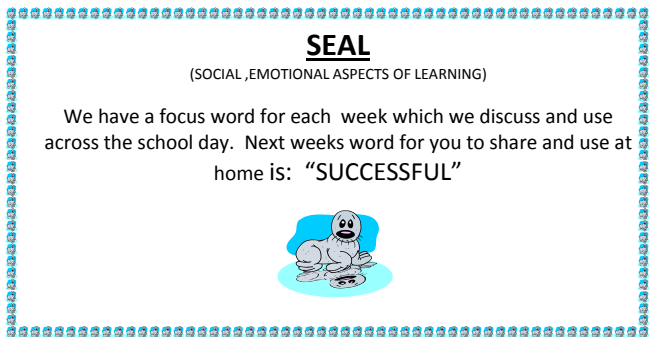
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BRAIN TUMOUR CHARITY

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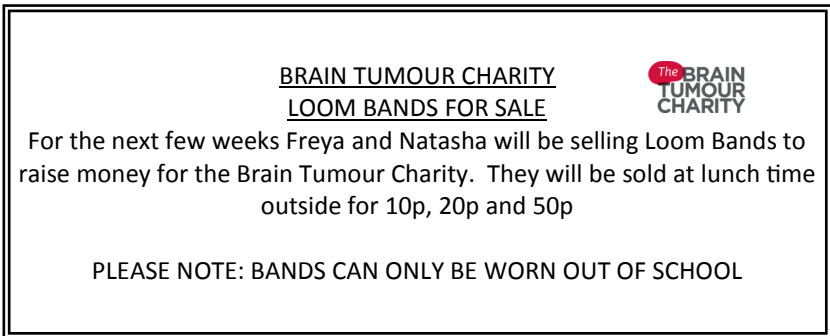
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Junior Challenge

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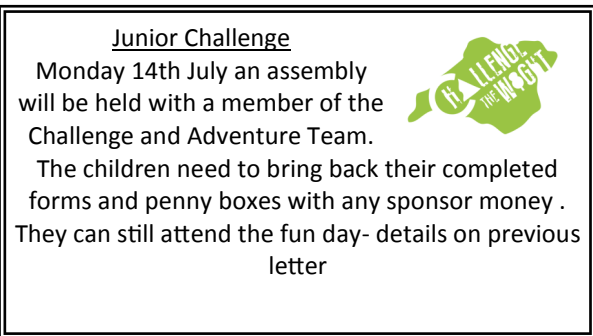
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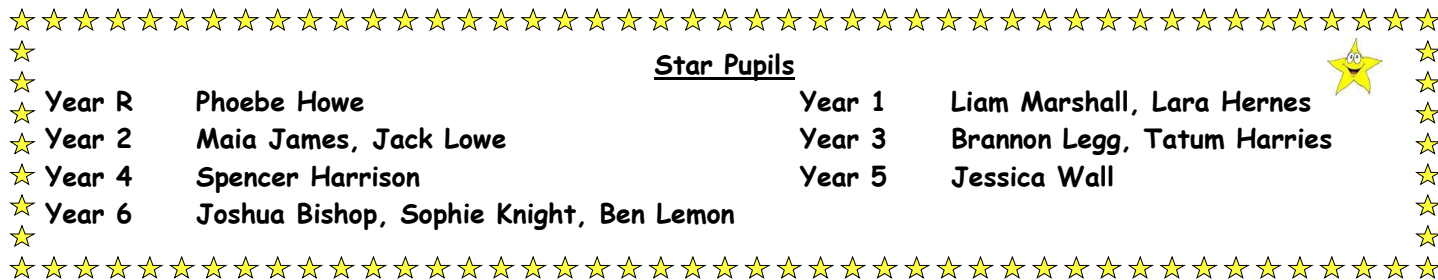

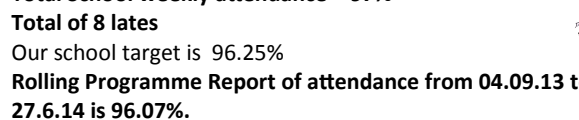
