We have an exciting new event to tell you about, but which will support school, as well as the Hampshire and Isle of Wight Air Ambulance. On Sunday 17th May we will be holding a 5 mile charity run for adults and two shorter routes for children. Entry will be £12.50 for adults and £5 for children. This will include entry, medals and refreshments on return. We are going to involve the children in the designing of the medals, and hope that this will be an annual event through which we can support a variety of charities. The routes will be marshalled, and the starting point will be the school, with registration from 9.30am on the day. Entry forms can be requested from the school website or by contacting the school office. Running numbers can be collected on the morning. More details will be supplied with the entry form. The money raised will be donated to the Air Ambulance, who will then visit school with the helicopter during the summer term, so the children will be able to meet the pilots and have a look at the helicopter itself. We are also hoping for class photos to be taken in front of the helicopter. More details will be coming out to the children next week about the competition, and entry forms will be available from Monday. So, start limbering up and tell all of your friends too!
