Dear Parents and Friends,

Friday 16th September 2016

The year 6 children were absolutely superb during their residential trip to PGL last weekend. All of the children challenged themselves to try new experiences and really supported and encouraged each other brilliantly. It really is such a pleasure to spend time with the children in this way, and a real privilege as they allow you to be both a parent to them as well as a friend. The year 4 residential to Kingswood in Bembridge also went well- with great reports from Mrs Moore. For some of our children this is a big step as it is their first time away from home, and for some can be quite a daunting experience. Well done to all of the children in years 4 and 6 who have shown what great young people they are.

On Wednesday of this week, Ross Edmunds from Sustrans visited school and spoke to the children in assembly about keeping safe. The message was very clear to all of the children about the importance of wearing a helmet for scootering as well as cycling. If your child scooters to school, please ensure they have a helmet. Ross also spoke to the children about walking to school on Wednesday 5th October which is walk to school day. If you usually travel by car, would it be possible to park in the Rugby Football car park and walk through the rec so the children can participate? It would be great to get as many walkers as possible.

Now that the children have all settled into the rhythms and routines of their new classes it is important to appreciate the level of expectation for the year group. We have high expectations of all our children and want them to be the very best they can be. If you have not managed to attend the class meeting with the teacher, then please make sure that you ask for any paperwork that was handed out or look at the website for details about year group expectations and ways to help your child. Please also sign up for a one to one meeting with your child's class teacher to discuss their progress. These meetings are important to attend- if you do not come into school then please phone the office (882505) and staff will be happy to help you.

A polite reminder about drop off and collection times- the children are expected to be in class by 8.55am ready for the register to be taken and not arrive at 8.55am. The gates are shut at 8.55am to allow parents and carers time to leave through the hall. The children are due in assembly at 9.00am and it can be disruptive when children arrive late. At the end of the day, any child who is not collected by 3.10pm will be taken to Little Herons and a courtesy call will then be made to parents. A charge will be made for the session at Little Herons. Staff have meetings and clubs after school and are not able to sit with children who are not collected.

Next Friday we have the Isle of Wight Day, starting with the Big IOW Family Breakfast. The produce for the breakfast is all going to be sourced from local suppliers, so if you have not yet booked your space then please do- it is a great way to start the day! In the afternoon we have the IOW Fair from 2-5pm in the hall and on the field. Parents and Carers are welcome to come from 2pm although the children will not be released from classrooms until 3pm as usual, giving you the chance to enjoy a wander and some refreshments first. There will be Bouncy Castles on the field for the children to enjoy. Please come along and support the event.
