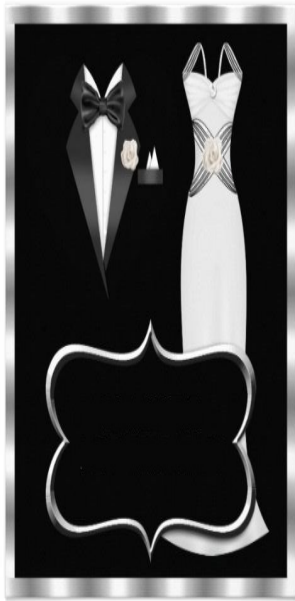
We are pleased to announce our Black Tie Event to raise money for our Outdoor Classroom.
