Headteacher's Update

Dear Parents,

Year 4 Kew Gardens Visit

I had great pleasure in joining Year 4 on Thursday on their educational visit to Kew Gardens. Morning Routine

We are always really pleased to see you in school in the mornings, in particular supporting your child with their start of the day task. Can I also remind you that parents are not permitted to enter any of the children's toilets and cloakrooms due to safeguarding requirements.
