Headteacher's Update

Dear Parents,

Welcome back to what is already looking like a very exciting and busy term! I hope you enjoyed the time with your children over half-term - it was lovely to see them back looking refreshed and eager to learn on Monday- long may it continue!

Thank you to Mrs Blake for the work she completed before half-term with the families who attended the lantern workshops. It was great to see lots of you at the Dark Night walk evenings last weekend, despite the cold! The New Carnival company presented some incredible art pieces to view on the walk and the work our Year 3 children did were part of this - they looked great! I also attended a meeting this week with the New Carnival company to hear about the Mardi Gras parade next year, which we would like to be part of again. The procession is taking place on Saturday 29th June in Ryde and we will hold a carnival club after Easter for the children to build their costumes and learn the dance routines. The theme this year is 'Biosphere Island', with different sections portraying the many elements of the Island. Once I know the section we have been allocated, I will update you.

Thank you for signing up for your child's parents' evening. If you have not done so already, the lists are outside your child's classroom for either Tuesday 27th or Thursday 29th November. At both of these sessions I will be displaying the building plan I have been given for the school refurbishment that is going to take place at the school starting next summer - it is very exciting and will provide the children with a lovely, improved learning environment - please take the time to have a look when you are here.

All schools on the Island have been given crocus bulbs for the children to plant in a cross formation to commemorate the servicemen who died in WW1. The bulbs have been donated by the Rotary Club to celebrate its worldwide aim to eradicate polio around the world. On Monday 12th November, Year 6 will lead a Remembrance service for the

school and the classes will explore the history of the war and the fourteen servicemen from Wootton who lost their lives in battle. We shall then plant the bulbs in the front school grounds. If you have an older family member who has any stories from the wars and would like to come and share these with the children, please let your child's class teacher know. We have poppies and other items for sale at school such as rulers, rubbers, pencils and key rings. School Council will take these around the classes every day next week so if your child would like to make a donation of at least 50p for an item, they can do so next week.

In the meantime I look forward to seeing you all at the one of the discos this evening!

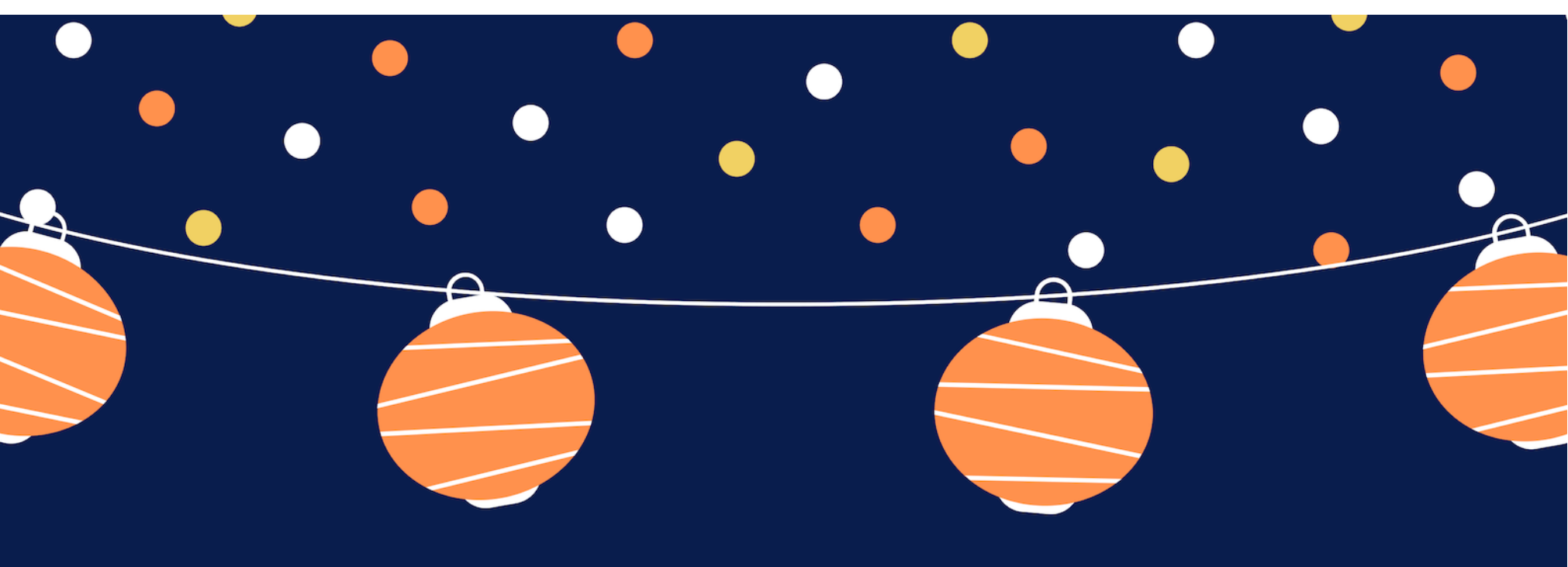
